






1. See the cap-tive Dan - iel kneel-ing at his prayer, Fear-less of the king's de - cree;

4. By the pro-phet's side God's an - gel stayed that night— Ne - ver did he flinch or yield;




True to God and con-science, strong to do and dare, Heed-ing not the tempt-er's plea.
